The Admissions Process

The main points of entry to Woldingham are at 11+ (Year 7), 13+ (Year 9) and Sixth Form, with occasional places available at 12+ and 14+. The Assessment Days are held in the Autumn Term and decisions are posted by mid December.

13+ candidates may apply for either standard entry (assessed in Year 8) or deferred entry (assessed in Year 6 with the 11+ candidates). Deferred entry offers are conditional upon the student continuing to make satisfactory progress at their current school. Students who accept a 13+ deferred place are required to sit the standard 13+ assessments in the Autumn prior to entry; this is to enable both setting and consideration for academic scholarship awards. Students may also apply for co-curricular scholarships in the Spring Term prior to entry and will be considered alongside the standard 13+ entry and internal candidates.

At Sixth Form there is an expectation that applicants will achieve at least 8 GCSEs, at an average of Grade 5.5 across all subjects taken. Grade 7 GCSE/IGCSE or better is normally required to take Mathematics, Sciences or Languages to A Level. For humanities subjects Grade 6 or better at GCSE/IGCSE is normally required.
