## **Notes on prizes and awards**

### **Awards**

Additional awards, in the form of a cup, shield or book token, are made under a number of different headings. Often there is a tradition or some history behind the award. These awards will only be made if a sufficiently high standard has been reached. These are:

#### ***The Extra-curricular Awards for Drama***

Awarded to students in different age groups who have contributed most to extra-curricular drama.

#### ***The Extra-curricular Awards for Music***

Awarded to students in different age groups who have contributed most to extra-curricular music.

#### ***The Stanway Award***

Donated by past parents and awarded to the Upper Sixth Music Ribbon.

#### ***The Extra-curricular Awards for Sport***

Awarded to students in different age groups who have contributed most to extra-curricular sport.

#### ***The Phil Dineen Award for Initiative***

Donated by Dr Dineen (Headmistress 1985-1997) and awarded for outstanding initiative that is of benefit to the school or in support of a good cause in the wider community.

#### ***The Clemency Hinde Cup***

Donated by a former member of staff for progress in English as an additional language.

#### ***The Sister Hinde Cup for Science***

Donated by the Khoo family on behalf of Sister Mary Hinde (Headmistress 1973-1984) and awarded to a Sixth Former who has made an outstanding contribution to science in the school.

#### ***The Keyte Trophy***

Donated by the Keyte family and awarded to the Sixth Form leaver who has contributed most to different aspects of school life.

#### ***The Deborah Ogle Award for Technology***

Donated by Staveley Industries to commemorate former student Deborah Ogle (1970-1991). It is awarded to the student who has demonstrated outstanding initiative in some form of technology. The award is a cheque for £100 to be used for the purchase of books and/or equipment directly associated with further study. This award is open to Sixth Form or Year 11 design and technology and/or computer science students.

#### ***The Vicky Feng Award for Entrepreneurial Spirit***

Donated by Vicky Feng (Sixth Form 2004-2006), a former student from mainland China, in recognition of the inspiration her business lessons gave her to start her own successful jewellery business. The Award is for outstanding business enterprise and initiative during the Sixth Form.

#### ***The Pickford Award for Life Drawing***

Awarded to a Sixth Form student who has excelled in life drawing.

***The Ann Benton Award for Creative Endeavour in Art***

Donated by Ann Benton (Head of Art 1989-2012). It is awarded to the student who has made creative and imaginative leaps in her journey through art.

***The Sister Rutledge Cup for Mathematics***

Donated by the Khoo family to commemorate Sister Joan Rutledge, who taught mathematics at Woldingham. It is awarded to the best Sixth Form mathematician.

***The Toyah Award for Personal Development***

Donated by the Watts family to commemorate their daughter Toyah (1970-1989) and awarded to the student who has shown the greatest development in personality and character during her years at Woldingham.

***The Diana Vernon Cup for Science***

Donated by Diana Vernon (Headmistress 2000-2007) and awarded to the most promising scientist. This award is available to students in Years 7-11.

***The Corbishley Debating Awards***

Awarded to the Sixth Form student who has made an outstanding contribution to debating throughout the year, and to the most promising debater in Years 7-11.

***The Greenway Prize for History***

Donated by the McGowan family and awarded to the most talented historian in the Upper Sixth.

***The Greenway Cup for Modern Languages***

Donated by the McGowan family and awarded to the most talented linguist in the Upper Sixth.

***The Murphy Cup for Classics***

Donated by past parents and awarded to the most able classics student in the school.

***The Woldingham Community Awards***

Awarded to students who have made outstanding contributions to their House or to the life of the school in general.

***The WSHA Leavers' Scholarships***

Awarded by the WSHA Committee to Sixth Form students to assist and develop their post-A Level plans. Successful candidates will have shown excellent qualities of organisation, time management and teamwork, displayed commitment to their academic studies and made significant contributions to Woldingham School and the wider community.

***Sixth Form Sacred Heart Awards***

The following awards are presented to the girls who have best represented each of the five goals of the Sacred Heart, embodying in their time at Woldingham the ideals of the Sacred Heart community:

**Faith** - which allows us to live responsibly in today's world, a world that has clearly moved into a period of rapid and, in many respects, turbulent change.

**Social justice** - a social awareness which impels to action so that each of us is ready to give, not merely receive.

**Community** - the building of a community prepared to look outside itself, where the emphasis is on sharing friendship and care as reflections of our relationship with God, as we live out our Christian values.

**Intellectual values** - a deep respect for scholarship and intellectual values.

**Personal growth** - personal growth in an atmosphere of wise and appropriate freedom.
