Summary of Role:

To be employed for the running of the school shop and daily duties including opening and closing, stock control and sales.

Specific Responsibilities:

1. To order and stock food, confectionary and merchandise
2. To present a sufficient range, quantity and quality of retail items to satisfy the everyday expectations and needs of customers of the school shop
3. To ensure the security of stock
4. To supervise and operate the shop during the opening hours;
5. To keep track of sales, cash and credit card transactions, including daily cashing up;
6. To prepare termly stock inventory lists
7. To establish sales margins on all items
8. To organise and train volunteer students
9. To ensure the shop is clean and tidy on a daily basis;
10. To open the school shop over the easter and summer holidays periods to cater for external hirer clients (optional additional available hours)
