<b>Position:</b>	Visiting Music Teacher (VMT) Trumpet Teacher. Flexible hours.
<b>Department:</b>	Music Department
<b>Reporting to:</b>	Director of Music
<b>Key purpose:</b>	We are seeking a talented and enthusiastic Trumpet VMT to join our dynamic music team. As a VMT, you will play a vital role in delivering high-quality Trumpet instruction to students of various ages and skill levels. Your passion for music, combined with your exceptional teaching skills, will contribute to fostering a love for music and facilitating skill development among our students.

### General tasks and responsibilities:

- To teach Trumpet across 11 – 18 range of pupils varying from beginner to Diploma standard. Lessons are either 30 or 60 minutes.
- To direct or assist with ensembles where requested by The Director of Music.
- To operate within VMT guidelines as specified by Woldingham School.
- To monitor, record and report on pupils' progress.
- To meet administrative deadlines.
- To assist in preparing pupils to GCSE and/or A level performance coursework and recordings.
- To assist in preparing pupils for Internal and External concerts, competitions and performances.
- To prepare pupils for entry to Junior and/or Senior conservatoire entry.
- To be responsible for assessing stock – reporting need for maintenance, repair, purchase and hire to the Director of Music.
- Willing to be part of a team and be flexible and diverse.
- To communicate regularly with parents and other staff.
- To timetable lessons appropriately to ensure that lessons do not fall on the same academic subject more than one every 6 weeks.
